## Pollinator Habitat Creation & Enhancement

Maintained and enhanced MSU's Honey Bee Research site and Pollinator Garden, which is 0.5-acre site located at the Horticulture Research Farm near MSU's main campus. The site was developed with students and volunteers from the community. In non-pandemic years, this site is used for K-12 field trips, hosting beekeeping organization meetings, holding informational sessions on plants for pollinators and pollinator health.
